This project was at three locations where Braun removed and replaced large culverts. One large 108" corrugated metal pipe in late fall of 2019. In Summer of 2020 we installed a large Box Culvert, and another large corrugated pipe. All locations involved subgrade stabilization, embankment, rock and masonry retaining wall construction, keyed riprap, streambed aggregate and fish rocks for habitat enhancement.
